

## **Randall Scarlata, baritone**

Hailed for his warm, expressive sound, consummate musicianship and winning way with the audience, baritone Randall Scarlata enjoys an unusually diverse career. He is equally comfortable in Bach and Händel oratorio, Mozart and Verdi operas, the great song cycles, works from Tin Pan Alley, and the newest new music. He has appeared as soloist with many of the world's finest orchestras, and at international music festivals on five continents. Mr. Scarlata has given world premieres of works by Ned Rorem, Lori Laitman, George Crumb, Daron Hagen, Samuel Adler, Mohammed Fairouz, Paul Moravec, Christopher Theofanidis, Wolfram Wagner and Thea Musgrave. He has been the winner of many competitions, including the International Schubert Competition in Vienna (das Schubert Lied), the Joy in Singing Competition, the Brahms Competition, The Young Concert Artists Competition, the Naumburg Competition, and the Alice Tully Debut Recital Award. In addition, he has recorded for the Naxos, Arabesque, Albany, Chandos, CRI and Gasparo labels. Mr. Scarlata holds degrees from the Eastman School of Music, the Juilliard School, and also attended Vienna's Hochschule für Musik as a Fulbright Scholar. He is on the faculty of the School of Music of West Chester University and regularly gives masterclasses in the United States and abroad.
