

Known for versatility, consummate musicianship, and winning way with the audience, Randall Scarlata's repertoire spans five centuries and sixteen languages. He is a regular guest with important chamber ensembles, symphony orchestras, and early music groups across the world. A sought-after interpreter of new music, he has given world premieres of works by many renowned living composers. Mr. Scarlata has an extensive recording catalog, and his recording of Schubert's *Winterreise* with pianist Gilbert Kalish was honored with a Grammy nomination for Best Classical Vocal Solo.

Mr. Scarlata is Co-Artistic Director of the AlpenKammerMusik Chamber Music Festival in the Austria Alps during the summer, and regularly gives masterclasses throughout the United States and abroad. In 2019, he joined the faculty of the Tanglewood Music Center, and of the Peabody Conservatory of Johns Hopkins University. He previously served on the faculties of West Chester University and SUNY Stony Brook.
